To assist with the overpopulation of perch in Lake Chaparral, we are hosting the 2024 Lake Chaparral Ice Fishing Derby – help us encourage a healthy ecosystem for the lake by catching all the perch you can!

Rules and Regulations:

- Residents are entitled to a maximum of two (2) guests each to also participate in the event.
- Combining catches between participants is not permitted and will result in disqualification.
- All participants are responsible for the proper and safe disposal of any [yellow perch](#) caught; perch are not to be returned to the lake once caught.
 - **All other fish (trout and carp) are catch and release only.**
- Ice-fishing is not permitted within 10 metres (30 feet) of any prepared ice surfaces (skating path, hockey rinks), lakefront properties, docks, or shorelines.
- Ice-fishing holes must be a minimum of 5-feet (1.5m) apart.

- A completed registration form must be submitted prior to **Friday, February 9th, 2023**, by emailing manager@lakechap.ca or by dropping off a physical form in-person.
- If you have not registered for the event, your participation in the Ice Fishing Derby will be considered invalid and you will not be entered to win any of the available prizes.

Other Notables:

- We strongly recommend all participants dress appropriately for the weather conditions.
- Participants must bring their own equipment – the LCRA will not be supplying ice-fishing equipment or cold weather gear.
- We strongly encourage all participants to use caution and safe practices when accessing the lake ice and while fishing.
- Complimentary coffee and hot chocolate will be provided.

Prize Categories:

- Adult (over 18 years of age)
 - Largest perch caught; smallest perch caught; most perch caught.
- Youth (under 18 years of age)
 - Largest perch caught; smallest perch caught; most perch caught.
